INSTRUCTIONS TO SCHOOLS

1. The question paper should be given to the candidates when schools open in January.
2. The materials for the project should be availed as soon as the instructions reach the schools.
 - (i) Good quality softwood or any other readily available type of timber may be used for carpentry work.
 - (ii) Masonry work should be on a firm and fairly level ground using bricks and blocks or stones depending on availability.
3. The subject teacher should ensure that the projects are **completed** and marked by **31st March 2026** for **milestone 1** and **31st July 2026** for **milestone 2**.
4. The subject teacher should ensure that the project marks are kept **confidential**.
5. At least 50% of the projects work randomly selected from the poor, fair and good candidate's work must be preserved and should not be disposed off until three months after KCSE results are released.
6. Each school is expected to comply by the work plan provided.
7. Each candidate should construct **own individual project**. **Group work is not be allowed**.
8. It is the responsibility of the principal to ensure that:
 - (i) Project marks are sent to the KNEC through the KNEC portal by the dates stated above.
 - (ii) Pictorial evidence is sent to KNEC by the stated dates;
 - (iii) A copy of the project marks is **confidentially kept** by the school.
