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1. Ways human beings can protect animals.

- i. Providing shelter for domestic animals.

2. Ways in which CRE helps learners in their moral growth.

- i. CRE teaches learners what is right and wrong / good and bad/ practice moral values.
- ii. The study gives learners examples of personalities who succeeded by doing what is right/ good while others who failed for doing what is wrong/ bad.
- iii. It teaches learners to respect/ obey God/ parents/ authorities.
- iv. Through the subject, they learn how to avoid sin and its consequences.
- v. Through CRE, learners acquire life skills which enable them to navigate challenging circumstances in their lives/ make right judgments.
- vi. It provides knowledge to the learners on the emerging issues in order to avoiding falling victims/ into temptations when faced by such matters in their lives.
